

Discussion questions on Psalm 27, "Seeking God."

1. Which of the following means of communication best describes your prayer life... long walk together... face-to-face... phone call... email... text message... or tweet?
2. Read again the psalm and answer this question: "why should we seek – and keep seeking – after God?"
3. What are some of the reasons we don't actively and intentionally seek God? How should you deal with these?
4. If Jesus were to ask you the question, "what – or who – are you looking for?" (John 1:38; 20:15), how would you answer?
5. What do the following passages teach us about seeking God: Deut. 4:29; Psalm 70:4; Isaiah 55:6, 7; Matthew 7:7, 8; Acts 17:27; Colossians 3:1?
6. Share your personal experience (and any blessing that you received) from an extended time alone with God. When is your next appointment with God?
7. "One thing..." (27:4; cf. Luke 10:42; Phil. 3:13) What have you given up – or what are you willing to give up – in order to seek a fresh discovery of God and his goodness?
