“The End of All Things at Hand: Preparing for Judgment “

1.) v. 1-3 How does suffering with the same attitude as Christ (I Pet 2) help free us from the power of temptation?

2.) How honest is Peter about our former way of life? What benefit is there to being open/honest about our past?

3.) v.4-6 How does thinking about God’s judgment keep us from our former sins?

4.) v. 7-9 What practical commands does Peter give to us knowing the end is near? How can we obey these?

5.) How are you doing getting ready for the coming of judgment? (see I Cor. 4:1-5, 11:28) What could you change to be better prepared?

6.) What helps you love others with “fervent love”? What hinders?

7.) v. 10-11 Which believers have received at least one spiritual gift? What is your responsibility with your spiritual gift?

8.) v. 11 What happens when we all engage using our spiritual gifts? How earnestly do you want that?

9.) How might you demonstrate that desire?
