

## ***Truths That Transform, “Sanctification” discussion questions.***

(Sermon on Romans 6:14-23, December 13, 2009)

1. What does it mean to be “under grace” and not “under the law”? (6:14) How could people misconstrue this truth?
2. Why should we not use grace as a means or excuse to sin? How should grace challenge us to live?
3. What does it mean to obey? (6:16) What two options of obedience do we have?
4. List some practical ways you can present your members as slaves to righteousness. (6:19)
5. What is sanctification? (6:19, 22) How would you explain this process to another person? Why is it important to know about it?
6. Why is the truth that we have been set free from sin so important in the process of sanctification? (6:20-23) Why does Paul contrast the “wages of sin” with “gift of God” in v. 23?
7. Are there certain sins that you are good at hiding from others? Who can you confess these sins to?
8. What are the next steps in your own life to remember the gospel that has set you free and started you on this process of sanctification?
