

Truths that Transform The Incarnation

John 1:1-5 John calls Jesus “the Word.” What does this tell us about the Lord? What details does John mention regarding Jesus’ role/relationships before history began? What does this imply about our being? How might this reality affect our affection for Him?

What does John teach by saying “In Him was life”? How does His life affect our lives? How about the lives of all men? How should this reality affect our attitude toward Him?

John 1:4-5 How does light affect darkness and visa versa? How has Jesus’ light been impacting your life the past month?

John 1:14 Why might John emphasize that Jesus “became flesh”? How does it make you feel that God would want to come and dwell, “hang out” with us? How can we today behold the glory, grace and truth of Christ?

II Cor 8:9 What were some of the sacrifices Jesus made in order to purchase our redemption? How should this affect our response to His call on our lives?

Phil 2:5-11 How does it strike you to worship the God who is supremely humble? What might “emptying himself” involve for the eternal Son to become a mortal? How can we practice having “this attitude in ourselves that was also in Christ Jesus” in our marriages, our work, and even our play?

I John 3:5 Why is Jesus so determined to take away sin? Does it make that much difference or not? If so, how should this impact our view of sin?

I John 3:8-10 What does John mean saying “the one who practices sin is of the devil”? Can a true believer practice sin? What might this say about my familiar sins? How does Christ demand I let Him deal with my sin?

Hebrews 4:15 How does Jesus’ incarnation help me to be free from besetting sin?

Colossians 1:27 Now that Jesus has defeated sin and risen, how does the reality of the incarnation affect us today?
