

Discussion questions, “Being His Witness – The Church” Acts 2:41-47

1. What does it mean to be his witness in our day-to-day lives? In your day to day life?
2. What do you appreciate most about the bible? How do you devote yourself to the reading and study of the bible?
3. How have you experienced fellowship with other Christians to be important and even necessary in your own life?
4. How is your prayer life? In what ways can you make prayer more consistent in your own life and with the fellowship?
5. What does it look like for the larger fellowship or your house group to “have all things in common?”
6. Why do you think it is important to be faithful in attending church and living out v. 42? What hinders you from being more faithful in meeting together with the fellowship?
7. The early church had “favor with all the people” and the “Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.” What do you think that practically looked like for the early church? What would it look like for you to be actively telling others about your faith in Jesus Christ? Who are those people you will commit to pray for and build a relationship with trusting God for opportunities to tell them about Jesus?
