This week we will be looking at what theologians call the “incommunicable attributes,” those qualities that He alone possesses as the one true Creator and Sovereign Ruler over all. Next week we will look at the elements of God’s nature that He has reflected in man upon making us in His divine image. May we be lost in wonder as we contemplate together His eternal glory, wisdom, majesty and might. This week we meditate on Isaiah 40. Please read this chapter in its entirety as you begin.

1) Please summarize this chapter in one sentence.

2) Isaiah 40:1 How does looking at the majesty of God prove a powerful comfort to us?

3) 40:6-8 How is mankind like grass and how does the eternal Word stand in comparison?

4) God requires we turn to His eternal, holy Word to find guidance, insight and comfort therein. Can you share a moment when this recently happened in your times with the Lord?

5) 40:9 gives us clear instruction. What must we do? How does shouting God’s praises work in our souls? How can you do better at obeying these commands?

6) 40:10-11 tells us two things about the “arms” of the Lord. How does God use His strength on behalf of those who love Him? And how about to those who don’t love/obey Him? What does this stir in you?

7) 40:25-26 Who is like God in wisdom, might and majesty? How is it that we are enticed to worship other things, or to seek to control things ourselves? When you want to be “in control” how does God view your attitude? How might getting a more realistic glimpse of God help you when you feel “out of control”?

8) 40:27 Can you give an example of a time when you acted as if you didn’t expect God to be there or aware? How can we live more aware of God’s infinite presence and knowledge? How do God’s infinite wisdom, might and presence comfort us?

9) 40:28-31 Precious child of God, are you weary? Where do you lack strength? What must you do to receive strength from the Almighty? How might you make “waiting on God” a larger part of your identity, schedule and inclination?

Let’s take a few moments and pray for one another that we make time to “Behold Him” and be transformed by the experience. To know God and His Son Jesus Christ is eternal life.
